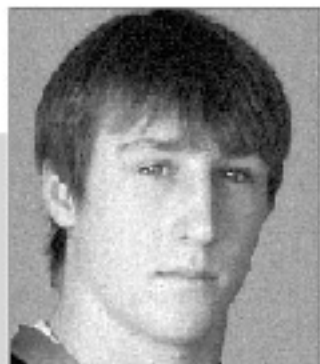

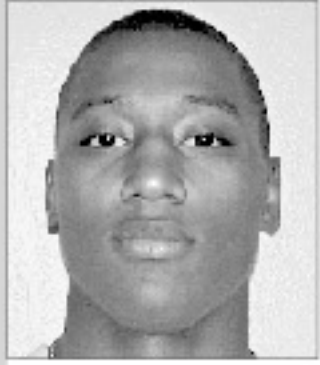
Sean Lee
School: Upper St. Clair Pos: RB-DB
Ht: 6-3 Wt: 215 Year: Sr.
With a strong senior season, Lee attracted more and more interest from college coaches. Has offers from Penn State, Iowa, West Virginia and Georgia Tech, among others. Rushed for 1,240 yards on 187 carries and scored 21 TDs. Was a standout safety. Being recruited to play linebacker.



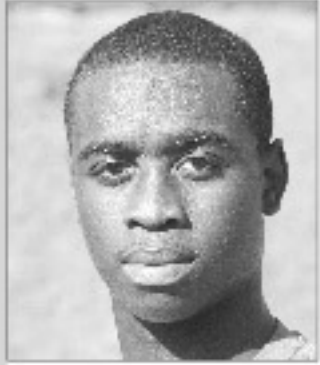
David Harvey
School: Penn Hills Pos: WR-DB
Ht: 6-1 Wt: 180 Year: Sr.
Considered one of the top receivers in the state. Caught 35 passes for 577 yards and scored nine touchdowns. Three-year starter who caught 95 career passes for 2,100 yards (22.1 average). Has Division I college offers and said he would most likely choose between West Virginia and Penn State.



Jason Kacinko
School: Penn-Trafford Pos: OT-DL
Ht: 6-6 Wt: 300 Year: Sr.
He never played football before his freshman year, concentrating instead on swimming. But he developed into a heavily recruited offensive lineman. He is a three-year starter who has numerous scholarship offers. Purdue, Maryland, Wisconsin, Michigan State and Pitt are among his finalists.



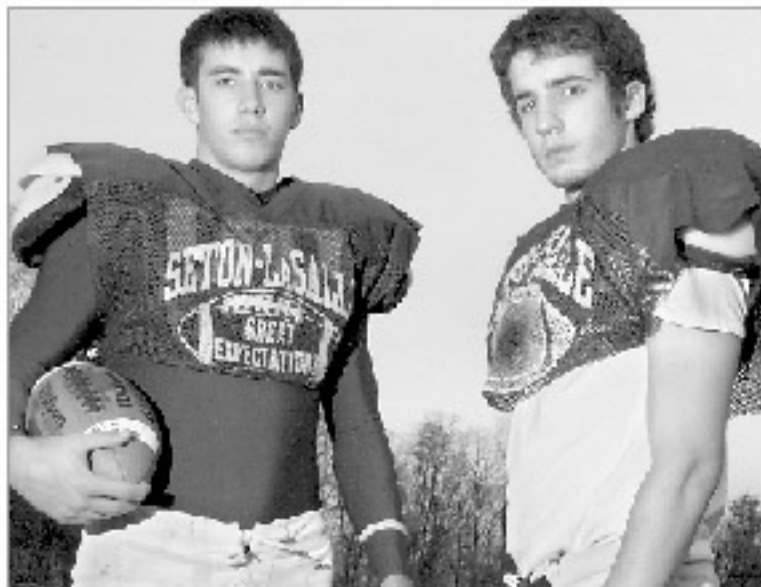
Tommie Campbell
School: Aliquippa Pos: WR-DB
Ht: 6-4 Wt: 190 Year: Sr.
A two-way standout for the WPIAL Class AA runner-up Quips. Has excellent speed and led team in receptions with 26 for 252 yards. Scored 11 touchdowns. Was third on the team in tackles with close to 100. Also intercepted four passes, and returned one for TD. Has a scholarship offer from Pitt.



Desmond Brentley
School: Perry Pos: QB
Ht: 6-2 Wt: 220 Year: Jr.
Brentley blossomed into a standout quarterback in his first season as Perry's starter. He led the Commodores to their fifth consecutive City League championship. Has completed 133 of 233 (57 percent) for 2,049 yards and 20 touchdowns. A Division I college prospect for next season.

Bill Stull

School: Seton-LaSalle Pos: QB
Ht: 6-3 Wt: 190 Year: Sr.
One of the best passing quarterbacks in WPIAL history. This season, became the first WPIAL QB to throw for 3,000 yards in a season. Has completed 228 of 367 (60 percent) for 3,198 yards and 40 touchdowns. Teamed with receiver Carmen Connolly and helped Rebels to WPIAL Class AA title. Passed for championship game record 323 yards. Heads into PIAA playoffs as the fourth-leading passer in WPIAL history with 5,460 yards. Has completed 382 of 623 and has 62 touchdown passes. Has some Division I scholarship offers from Kentucky, Wisconsin and Mid-American Conference schools, among others. Transferred from Mt. Lebanon after freshman year.

Carmen Connolly

School: Seton-LaSalle Pos: WR-DB
Ht: 6-1 Wt: 183 Year: Sr.
Connolly teamed with QB Bill Stull to make the most prolific pass-catch combination in WPIAL history. Connolly has a state record 11.2 receptions this season for 1,545 yards. He is tied for 10th on the all-time national list. Caught 14 passes in one game and 13 in another. He also has scored 17 touchdowns this season for the WPIAL Class AA champion Rebels. For his career, Connolly has 217 receptions for 2,976 yards. He played running back as a sophomore and rushed for more than 800 yards. Toledo, Bowling Green and Kent State have offered scholarships as well as some I-AA schools. Most colleges are recruiting him for defense.

Justin King

School: Gateway Pos: RB-DB
Ht: 6-0 Wt: 180 Year: Sr.
Recently made verbal commitment to Penn State, choosing Nittany Lions over Michigan, Florida and Ohio State. Will play defensive back at PSU. Rated by some scouting services as one of top 10 players in the country. For career, had 544 carries for 4,519 yards, third-best in WPIAL Class AAAA history. Had 59 touchdowns. This year, led Gateway to WPIAL title game for the first time since 1986. Rushed for 1,900 yards on 208 carries and scored 33 touchdowns that averaged 32.9 yards. Had 25 solo tackles and one interception on defense.

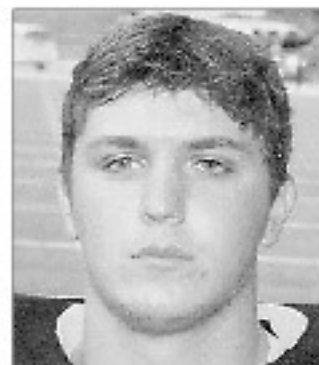


Eugene Jarvis

School: Central Catholic Pos: RB
Ht: 5-7 Wt: 165 Year: Sr.
The diminutive one has been gigantic for Central Catholic the past few seasons. Was Post-Gazette Player of the Year in 2003. This season, has rushed for 1,686 yards on 208 carries and scored 26 TDs, despite missing three games with hamstring injury. Helped Vikings to second consecutive WPIAL Class AAAA championship and set AAAA title game record with 221 yards rushing. Needs 180 yards to become the fifth runner in WPIAL Class AAAA history to rush for 4,000 career yards. West Virginia and a few MAC schools have offered scholarships.



Ed Collington
School: Penn Hills Pos: RB
Ht: 5-11 Wt: 210 Year: Sr.
Nicknamed "Horse," he galloped to 1,700 yards rushing on 183 carries and 22 touchdowns for WPIAL Class AAAA semifinalist Penn Hills. Was WPIAL's second-leading rusher in regular season. Had 2,975 career yards on 354 attempts. Akron has offered a scholarship and other Division I schools are interested.



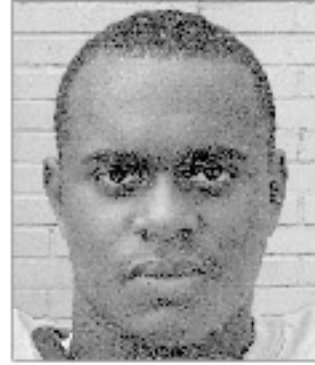
John Pelusi
School: Central Catholic Pos: TE-DE
Ht: 6-3 Wt: 235 Year: Sr.
Latest in a long line of talented tight ends at Central Catholic. He is a good blocker and receiver who has 14 catches for 244 yards. He is also a talented defensive end. Boston College, West Virginia, Northwestern, Stanford and Pitt are among the schools that have offered scholarships.



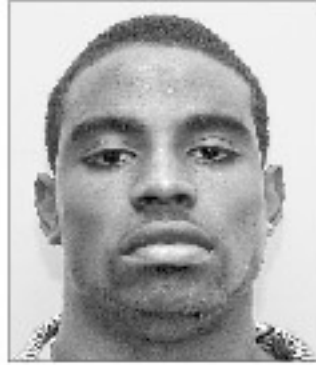
Jeremy Bruce
School: Blackhawk Pos: RB-DB
Ht: 5-9 Wt: 185 Year: Sr.
Helped Blackhawk to the WPIAL Class AAA semifinals two years in a row. Rushed for 1,280 yards on 206 carries and scored 16 touchdowns this year. Rushed for 1,767 as a junior and caught 23 passes. Committed to West Virginia before the start of the season. Recruited to play receiver.



Brad Dawson
School: Thomas Jefferson Pos: QB-DB
Ht: 6-1 Wt: 180 Year: Sr.
Switched from receiver to quarterback as a senior and helped the Jaguars win the WPIAL Class AAA championship. Has completed 108 of 207 passes for 1,922 yards and 18 touchdowns. Has intercepted 10 passes and returned four for touchdowns. Some MAC colleges are showing interest.



Shane Brooks
School: Duquesne Pos: RB-LB
Ht: 5-11 Wt: 220 Year: Sr.
Has more than a dozen scholarship offers from Division I schools. He is favoring Virginia, but also is considering Maryland and Wisconsin. Rushed for 1,545 yards on 219 carries this season and scored 13 TDs. Played as a freshman at South Allegheny and had 3,958 career yards on 597 attempts.



Dana Brown
School: Clairton Pos: RB-DB
Ht: 5-11 Wt: 190 Year: Sr.
One of the primary reasons Clairton made it to the WPIAL Class A championship game. Rushed for 2,137 yards on 225 carries and scored 36 touchdowns. Rushed for 844 yards as a junior. Also talented DB. Attended South Allegheny as a freshman. Has scholarship offers from Ohio and Kent State.



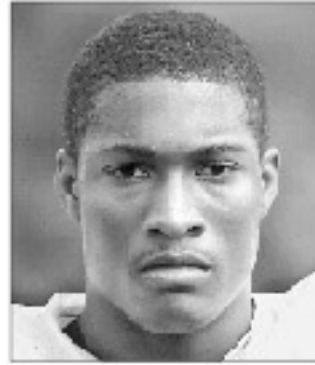
Tyler Huether
School: Penn-Trafford Pos: QB
Ht: 6-1 Wt: 190 Year: Jr.
Huether (pronounced "heater") will be one of the top quarterback prospects in the WPIAL next season. He is one of four non-seniors on the Fabulous 22. He had a big junior season, completing 127 of 209 (61 percent) for 2,209 yards. Threw for 21 touchdowns and had only six interceptions.



John Bachman
School: Moon Pos: OT-DT
Ht: 6-4 Wt: 255 Year: Sr.
A starter since his freshman year. He made All-Parkway Conference on offense and defense the past two seasons. Led team in tackles this season and had three sacks. Turned down scholarships from Pitt and Mid-American Conference schools and committed to Indiana of the Big Ten.



Shane Murray
School: Central Catholic Pos: QB-DB
Ht: 6-2 Wt: 193 Year: Sr.
Has 3,553 yards of offense the past two seasons for the two-time WPIAL Class AAAA champions. This year, he has completed 72 of 151 for 1,229 yards and 17 TDs. Also has rushed 86 times for 385 yards. Threw for 1,308 and rushed for 631 as a junior. Also an excellent safety. Has scholarship offer from Pitt.



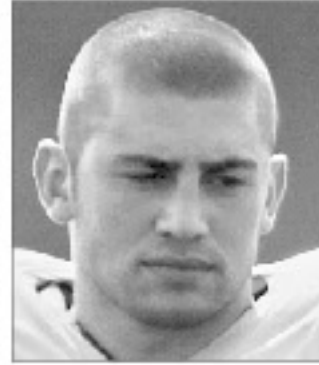
Dorin Dickerson
School: West Allegheny Pos: RB-LB
Ht: 6-2 Wt: 200 Year: Jr.
Mr. Versatility for the 11-1 Indians. He rushed for 1,036 yards on 141 carries and scored 21 TDs. Team's second-leading receiver with 25 catches for 517 yards. Also lined up at QB sometimes. An excellent linebacker on defense. One of WPIAL's top college prospects for next season.



Steve Paskorz
School: Hampton Pos: RB-LB
Ht: 6-2 Wt: 200 Year: So.
Only the sixth sophomore to make the Fabulous 22. He switched from QB to running back shortly before first game of season. Led WPIAL in regular-season rushing and finished with 2,187 yards on 190 attempts. Scored 27 TDs. Had five games of 200 yards or more. Also a force on defense.



Kevin Gamer
School: West Mifflin Pos: FB-DE
Ht: 6-2 Wt: 225 Year: Sr.
A starter since his freshman season. He had 14 quarterback sacks this season and also was one of the leading tacklers on the WPIAL Class AAA runner-up Titans. A good blocker on offense. West Virginia, Toledo, Kent State, Central Michigan and Eastern Michigan have offered scholarships.



Mike Barlak
School: Gateway Pos: LB
Ht: 6-2 Wt: 215 Year: Sr.
One of the top linebackers in the WPIAL. He was the Gators' leading tackler a year ago and was second this year with 69 assists and 49 solos. Had six sacks, two fumble recoveries, two interceptions and two forced fumbles. Also played some at running back. Some Division I colleges are interested.
