**ORDER OF COURT**

AND NOW, this 8 day of August, 2007, it is now ORDERED,

ADJUDGED and DECREED as follows:

1. The parties shall maintain the status quo, as of the date of this Order, of all marital tangible personal property and the other party's non-marital tangible property wherever located.
2. Parties shall provide, within ten (10) days of this Order, a verified statement that he/she has delivered to the other party all original inventories, household logs and appraisals within the possession, custody or control of each party, of all marital and non-marital tangible personal property. All original inventories and household logs in Husband's possession, custody or control, including but not limited to those found at Wit's End by Husband's or Wife's counsel, shall be produced within five (5) days. This does not apply to any inventory arising from Husband's previous divorce; however, Husband shall use his best efforts to obtain the consent of Frances Scaife to release the Inventory to Wife.

3. Wife shall, at her sole election have the right to retrieve personalty and/or through her designated agents, (a) all marital personal property located at 613 Pitcairn Place prior to its remodeling beginning in 2004, and (b) Wife's personal effects, at such time and in such manner as she, in her sole discretion, shall determine and communicate to Husband. In the event Wife is to retrieve any items, she shall make arrangements with Husband's representatives to be present and involved in the retrieval.
