Yonkers Raceway at Empire City, NY

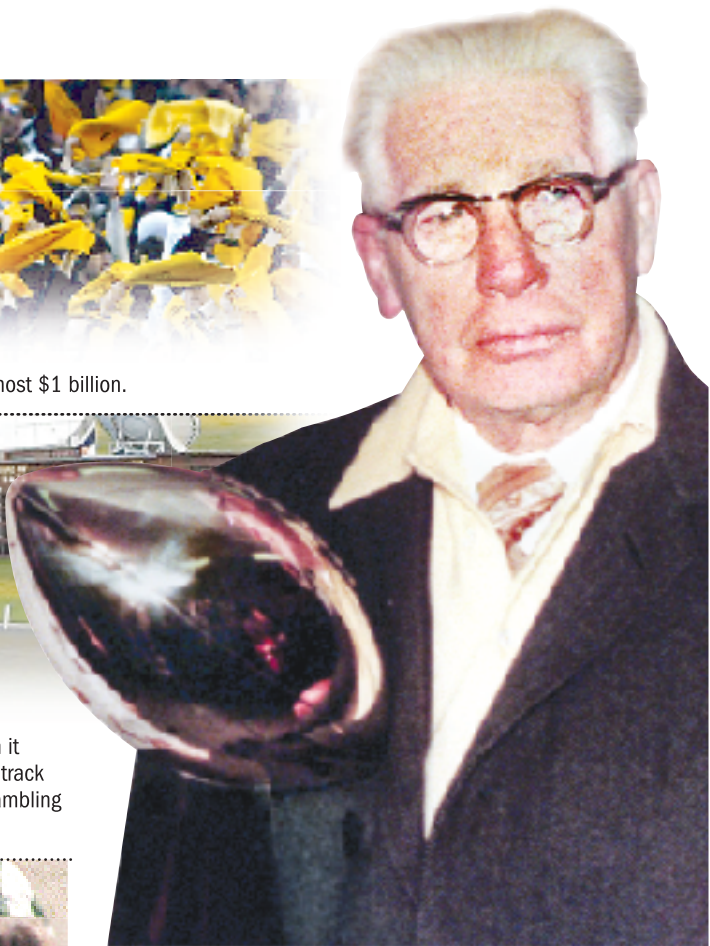
The Yonkers track had fallen on hard times but began a rebirth in late 2006, when it opened the first legal video gambling parlor in metropolitan New York. At that time, track officials said their aim was to transform it into the largest racetrack-based video gambling operation in the country. Timothy J. Rooney is the raceway's president.

Palm Beach Kennel Club, West Palm Beach, Fla.

The Palm Beach Kennel Club features live greyhound races and wagering on televised horse racing and dog racing from other tracks and jai alai, plus 60 tables of poker games, according to its Web site. Patrick J. Rooney, listed as the president, owner and operator of the track, in 2002 called it the most profitable of all the Rooney holdings.
