

## Anatomy of history

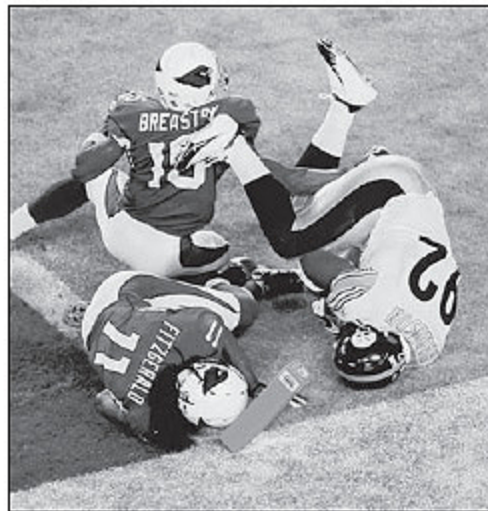

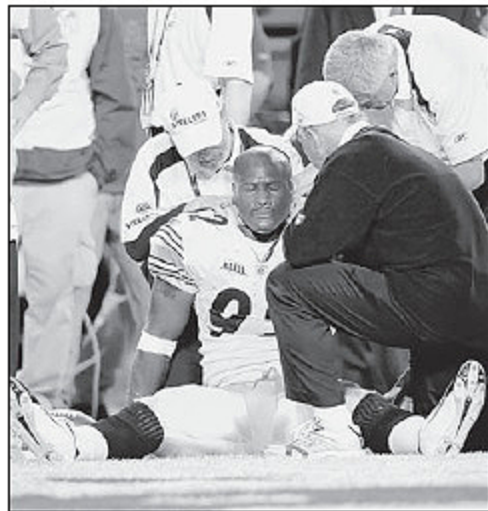
