Narrative

The undersigned has probable cause to believe the above-named defendant, on the 17 day of October, 2009, at approximately 21:35 []a.m. [X]p.m. at 4000 CENTRAL FLORIDA BV (Zone 22) in Orange County did

On Saturday, October 17, 2009, at approximately 2100, I was working in an off-duty capacity at the University of Central Florida's Bright House Networks Stadium located at 4000 Central Florida Boulevard Orlando, Florida 32816. I was providing security for the patrons in section 129 through 131 attending the University of Central Florida versus the University of Miami football game. Standing next to me was Mr. Reginald Jones, who is a member of the Event Staff and he was also providing security for the patrons in my area of responsibility.

Mr. Jones and I were approached by Ms. Kimisha Singh regarding an uncooperative subject sitting in her seat. Mr. Jones requested Ms. Singh's ticket which indicated she was suppose to be seated in section 131, row W, in seat seven (7). Mr. Jones and I escorted Ms. Singh to her seat and observed the defendant, later identified as Ms. Anshonae Mills sitting in Ms. Singh's seat. Mr. Jones asked Ms. Mills to provide a ticket for the seat she was sitting in. Ms. Mills stated she was a student and did not need a ticket. Furthermore, Ms. Mills stated the seat she was sitting in is designated for "handicapped people" and informed Mr. Jones she knew Ms. Singh was not handicapped and should not be sitting in the seat anyway.

Mr. Jones explained to Ms. Mills every seat in the stadium had been sold and Ms. Singh produced a valid ticket for the seat she occupied. Ms. Mills told Mr. Jones an unidentified law enforcement officer told her she could sit in the seat. Mr. Jones told Ms. Mills the law enforcement officer provided her with incorrect information and she had to vacate her seat because it had been sold. Ms. Mills became upset, looked at Mr. Jones' uniform and told him "you are just a security guard and you cannot make me leave." Mr. Jones politely informed Ms. Mills where the student section of the Bright House Networks Stadium was, but Ms. Mills refused to vacate her seat.

Ms. Mills continued to debate Mr. Jones about vacating Ms. Singh's seat, meanwhile I intervened and told her she needed to vacate the seat so Ms. Singh could sit down. Ms. Mills stood up, began yelling at Mr. Jones and I, and questioned our authority to make her leave because she was a "student." At this point, Ms. Mills unruly behavior had begun to attract the attention of other patrons trying to enjoy the game, so I directed her to leave the area. Ms. Mills verbally refused, so I placed my hand in the small of her back and utilized a soft assisting touch to direct her towards the exit. Ms. Mills turned towards my direction and pushed my hand away from her. I firmly grabbed Ms. Mills right bicep with my left hand and grabbed her right wrist with my right hand above her right wrist bone and attempted to guide her towards the exit. Ms. Mills attempted to break the hold I had on her left arm by lowering her center of gravity and snatching away from me. I maintained my grasp and escorted her down the steps away from the seating area.

During the time I took hold of Ms. Mills right arm, she resisted my efforts to control her by making physically evasive movements in the form of pushing and pulling away from me in an effort to not allow me to maintain my grasp of her left arm. While at the bottom of the stairs, I directed Ms. Mills towards a concrete wall in a controlled manner and held her there until I received assistance from Sergeant Kristen Bates from the Seminole County Sheriff's Office. Sergeant Bates and I then escorted Ms. Mills to the University of Central Florida's Police Department on site at the Bright House Networks Stadium.

Ms. Mills had a purse in her possession and one of the straps was broken as she resisted my efforts to control her. I received Ms. Mills information later during the booking process and never had control of her purse nor did I search her or her person during the arrest. An unidentified female police officer from the University of Central Florida searched Ms. Mills. Additionally, I was informed Ms. Mills gave someone from the University of Central

Florida's Police Department authorization to release her purse to an unidentified roommate. Ms. Mills was also issued a University of Central Florida trespass warning.

Based on the facts and circumstances of this case, I believed probable cause existed for Ms. Mills arrest because she did: resist this deputy sheriff, Corporal Tony Marlow. At the time of arrest, I was engaged in the lawful execution of a legal duty. I am a sworn law enforcement officer. At the time, I was dressed in a standard issue Orange County Sheriff's Office uniform. My shirt was green in color, with my name, Sheriff's star prominently displayed on my chest, two Orange County Sheriff's Office patches on each shoulder. I was wearing a duty belt, green pants, and my firearm was on my side. Ms. Mills knew I was a deputy sheriff and she wilfully remained in the Bright House Networks Stadium at the University of Central Florida even though she was asked to leave.

Additionally, the property is owned by the University of Central Florida, notice not to remain in the property was given to Ms. Mills by actual communication from me. The defendant remained on the property was without permission, of this deputy sheriff who was authorized at that time to give that permission.
