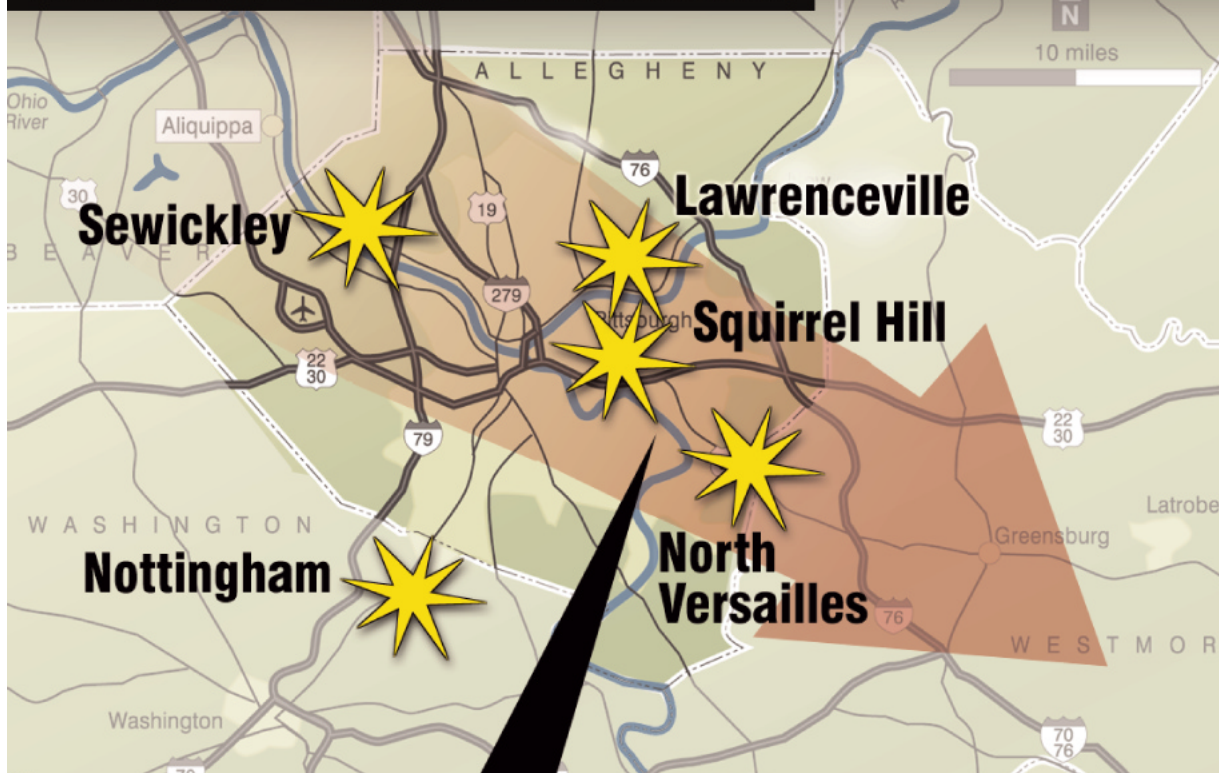


Deadly winds

About The Whip

- 1918: The first Whip, a 12-car model by W.H. Mangels, opens.
- 1926: Kennywood buys a new 16-car Whip from the same company as the first.
- 1968: The Whip is moved to a site near the Racer to make room for the Thunderbolt.
- 1995: The Whip is moved to Lost Kennywood and the building that used to house it is converted into a pavilion.
