1 Florida (12-0)
Yesterday: def. Florida State, 37-10
The game: Gators ran their winning streak to 22 games as QB Tim Tebow passed for three touchdowns and ran for two in his final game at The Swamp. Next: vs. Alabama, Saturday.

- 

2 Alabama (12-0)
Yesterday: Did not play
The game: Said coach Nick Saban after narrowly beating Auburn, 26-21, Friday: "The strong do survive, but the strong do get their [butts] kicked." Next: vs. Florida, Saturday.

- 

3 Texas (12-0)
Yesterday: Did not play
The game: In a big Heisman push, QB Colt McCoy had 479 yards of offense in the Longhorns' 49-39 win vs. rival Texas A&M Thursday. Next: vs. Nebraska, Saturday.

- 

4 TCU (12-0)
Yesterday: def. New Mexico, 51-10
The game: QB Andy Dalton passed for four TDs, and the BCS bowl-hopeful Horned Frogs put the wraps on their first undefeated season since 1938. Next: Bowl, TBA.

- 

5 Cincinnati (11-0)
Yesterday: Did not play
Of note: In his past 50 pass attempts, QB Tony Pike has thrown eight touchdowns including six Friday in a 49-36 victory against Illinois. Next: at Pitt, Saturday.

- 

6 Boise State (12-0)
Yesterday: Did not play
Of note: The Broncos clinched at least a share of the WAC title with a 44-33 victory vs. Nevada Friday. QB Kellen Moore passed for five touchdowns. Next: vs. New Mexico State, Saturday.

- 

7 Georgia Tech (10-2)
Yesterday: lost to Georgia, 30-24
Of note: Georgia took a page out of Georgia Tech's playbook, rushing for 339 yards to upset the Yellow Jackets and put a damper on the ACC title game. Next: vs. Clemson, Saturday.

- 

8 Pitt (9-2)
Yesterday: Did not play
Of note: RB Dion Lewis ran for 155 yards in a 19-16 loss to West Virginia Friday — his sixth consecutive 100-yard game. Next: vs. Cincinnati, Saturday.

- 

9 Ohio State (10-2)
Yesterday: Does not play
The game: The Buckeyes are the first team to win or share five consecutive Big Ten titles since Michigan accomplished the feat from 1988-92. Next: at Rose Bowl, Jan. 1.

- 

10 Oregon (8-3)
Yesterday: Did not play
The game: Freshman LaMichael James is seventh in NCAA Div. I-A in rushing with 1,310 yards (6.9 ypc). Next: vs. Oregon State, Thursday.

- 

11 Oklahoma State (9-3)
Yesterday: Lost to Oklahoma, 27-0
The game: The Cowboys' loss to the rival Sooners likely cost them any chance of a BCS at-large bid. DeMarco Murray scored twice for Oklahoma. Next: Bowl, TBA.

- 

12 Penn State (10-2)
Yesterday: Did not play
Of note: Barring an at-large bid to a BCS bowl game, the Nittany Lions would seem most likely to get the conference's bid to the Capital One Bowl in Orlando, Fla. Next: Bowl, TBA.

- 

13 Iowa (10-2)
Yesterday: Did not play
The game: Kirk Ferentz, an Upper St. Clair High School graduate, is 80-55 in his 11th season as coach of the Hawkeyes. He has had only three losing seasons. Next: Bowl, TBA.

- 

14 Virginia Tech (9-3)
Yesterday: def. Virginia, 42-13
The game: RB Ryan Williams ran for 182 yards and four touchdowns as the Hokies beat Virginia for the eighth time in their past nine meetings. Next: Bowl, TBA.

- 

15 Clemson (8-4)
Yesterday: Lost to South Carolina, 34-17
The game: South Carolina QB Stephen Garcia passed for three TDs as the Gamecocks won for only the third time in the past 13 games vs. in-state rival Clemson. Next: vs. Georgia Tech, Saturday.

- 

16 Oregon State (8-3)
Yesterday: Did not play
The game: The Beavers were just 2-2 after four games this season after dropping back-to-back games to Cincinnati and Arizona. Next: at Oregon, Thursday.

- 

17 LSU (9-3)
Yesterday: def. Arkansas, 33-30 (OT)
The game: K Josh Jasper kicked a 41-yard FG with 4 seconds to play to force overtime, then a 36-yarder to win it in OT. Ryan Mallet had rallied Arkansas with four TD passes. Next: Bowl, TBA.

18 BYU (10-2)
Yesterday: def. Utah, 26-23
The game: QB Max Hall threw a 25-yard touchdown pass to Andrew George in overtime for the winning points. It is the Cougars' third win vs. rival Utah in four seasons. Next: Bowl, TBA.

- 

19 Miami (9-3)
Yesterday: def. South Florida, 31-10
The game: Javarris Harris ran for two touchdowns, Jacory Harris passed for two and the Hurricanes capped their first nine-win regular season since 2005. Next: Bowl, TBA.

- 

20 Mississippi (8-4)
Yesterday: Lost to Mississippi State, 41-27
The game: Mississippi State backup QB Chris Reif accounted for three TDs and Anthony Dixon ran for 133 yards as the Bulldogs won the Egg Bowl. Next: Bowl, TBA.

- 

21 California (8-3)
Yesterday: Did not play
The game: QB Kevin Riley is second in the Pac-10 in passing yards (2,421), including a season-high 351 in a 23-21 win vs. Arizona State. Next: at Washington, Saturday.

- 

22 Utah (9-3)
Yesterday: lost to BYU, 26-23
The game: Junior RB Eddie Wide ran for 114 yards in the loss to the Cougars — his seventh 100-yard game of the season. Next: Bowl, TBA.

- 

23 North Carolina (8-4)
Yesterday: Lost to N. Carolina State, 28-27
The game: N.C. State's Russell Wilson passed for four TDs and the Wolfpack blocked a Tar Heels field-goal attempt with five minutes to play to preserve the upset. Next: Bowl, TBA.

- 

24 Southern California (7-3)
Yesterday: vs. UCLA, late
The game: Going into the game, the Trojans' vaunted run defense had surrendered 716 yards and nine touchdowns in its past two games. Next: vs. Arizona, Saturday.

- 

25 Houston (10-2)
Yesterday: vs. Rice, late
The game: Case Keenum threw for 323 yards and two TD and ran for another in the first half and Houston clinched the Conference USA West division title. Next: TBA.
