A look around the country on this first weekend of the 2010 college football season, with a look at how the Top 25 teams fared and what players made a difference:

AP TOP25 RESULTS & ROUNDUP

-  **1 Alabama (1-0)**
Saturday: def. San Jose State, 48-3
Of note: Trent Richardson ran for two touchdowns and Greg McElroy passed for 218 yards as the defending national champions won in a rout. Next: vs. Penn State, Saturday.
-  **2 Ohio State (1-0)**
Saturday: Did not play
Of note: The Buckeyes defeated Marshall, 45-7, in their opener Thursday night behind a strong performance from junior QB Terrelle Pryor. Next: vs. Miami (Fla.), Saturday.
-  **3 Boise State (0-0)**
Saturday: Did not play
Of note: Now that the Broncos have a top 3 preseason ranking, can the lovable underdogs still sneak up on the traditional football powers? Next: vs. Virginia Tech, Monday.
-  **4 Florida (1-0)**
Saturday: def. Miami (Ohio), 34-12.
Of note: Four INTs helped the Gators overcome a poor offensive showing. The offense managed only 212 yards, 72 of which came on a fourth-quarter run by Jeffrey Demps. Next: vs. South Florida.
-  **5 Texas (1-0)**
Saturday: def. Rice, 34-17
Of note: Tre' Newton ran for three touchdowns and QB Garrett Gilbert, the heir apparent to Colt McCoy, was 14 for 23 for 172 yards in his first start. Next: vs. Wyoming.
-  **6 TCU (1-0)**
Saturday: def. Oregon State, 30-21
Of note: QB Andy Dalton ran for two TDs and threw for another, and the Horned Frogs pulled away late from the Beavers. Next: Tennessee Tech, Saturday.
-  **7 Oklahoma (1-0)**
Saturday: def. Utah State, 31-24
Of note: DeMarco Murray ran for 218 yards and two TDs, and the Sooners survived an upset bid by the Aggies. Next: Florida St., Saturday.
-  **8 Nebraska (1-0)**
Saturday: def. Western Kentucky, 49-10
Of note: Taylor Martinez, the only freshman to start at QB for the Cornhuskers, ran for 127 yards and three TDs and passed for 136 yards in a sensational debut. Next: vs. Idaho, Saturday.
-  **9 Iowa (1-0)**
Saturday: def. Eastern Illinois, 37-7
Of note: Adam Robinson ran for 109 yards and three TDs, and QB Ricky Stanzi passed for 229 yards and a TD. Next: vs. Iowa State.
-  **10 Virginia Tech (0-0)**
Saturday: Did not play
Of note: Hokies QB Tyrod Taylor's quest to win Virginia Tech's first national championship begins with a big test against No. 3 Boise State. Next: vs. Boise State, Monday.
-  **11 Oregon (1-0)**
Saturday: def. New Mexico, 72-0
Of note: The Ducks had a record 720 yards in total offense in their rout of the Lobos. Kenjon Barber ran for a career-high 147 yards and four touchdowns. Next: at Tennessee.
-  **12 Wisconsin (0-0)**
Saturday: at UNLV, late
Of note: Wisconsin has had some close calls traveling west with late wins at Fresno State in 2008 and UNLV in '07. Next: vs. San Jose State, Saturday.
-  **13 Miami (1-0)**
Saturday: Did not play
Of note: The Hurricanes shut out Florida A&M, 45-0, Thursday night behind QB Jacory Harris' three TD passes. Next: at Ohio State, Saturday.
-  **14 Southern California (1-0)**
Saturday: Did not play
Of note: The Trojans defeated Hawaii, 49-36, Thursday night behind Matt Barkley's five touchdown passes. Next: vs. Virginia, Saturday.
-  **15 Pitt (0-1)**
Saturday: Did not play
Of note: Lost its opener at Utah, 27-24, in overtime. The defense allowed the Utes to gain 405 yards, 283 through the air. Next: vs. New Hampshire, Saturday.
-  **16 Georgia Tech (1-0)**
Saturday: def. South Carolina State, 41-10
Of note: QB Joshua Nesbitt ran for 130 yards and three TDs and Roddy Jones added two scoring runs. The Yellow Jackets rushed for 373 yards. Next: vs. Kansas.
-  **17 Arkansas (1-0)**
Saturday: def. Tennessee Tech, 44-3
Of note: Ryan Mallett was 21 for 24 for 301 yards and three TDs in leading the Razorbacks to the blowout victory. Next: vs. Louisiana-Monroe.
-  **18 North Carolina (0-1)**
Saturday: lost to LSU, 30-24
Of note: Quarterback T.J. Yates threw for 412 yards as the Tar Heels made things interesting by scoring two second-half touchdowns. Next: vs. Georgia Tech, Sept. 18.
-  **19 Penn State (1-0)**
Saturday: def. Youngstown State, 44-14.
Of note: Freshman Rob Bolden threw for 239 yards and two TDs. Chaz Powell had a 100-yard kickoff return and Joe Paterno notched career victory No. 395. Next: at Alabama, Saturday.
-  **20 Florida State (1-0)**
Saturday: def. Samford, 59-6
Of note: Christian Ponder threw four first-half TD passes and Greg Reid returned a punt 74 yards for another score in Jimbo Fisher's debut as Seminoles coach. Next: at Oklahoma, Saturday.
-  **21 LSU (1-0)**
Saturday: def. North Carolina, 30-24
Of note: Patrick Peterson had 257 yards in return yardage and scored on an 87-yard punt return as LSU built a 30-10 halftime lead and then held on. Next: at Vanderbilt, Saturday.
-  **22 Auburn (1-0)**
Saturday: def. Arkansas State, 52-26
Of note: QB Cam Newton threw for 186 yards and three TDs and ran for 171 yards and two more scores as the Tigers rolled. Next: at Mississippi State, Thursday.
-  **23 Georgia (1-0)**
Saturday: def. Louisiana-Lafayette, 55-7
Of note: QB Aaron Murray was 16 for 24, threw for three TDs and ran for another as the Bulldogs scored their most points in six seasons. Next: at South Carolina.
-  **24 Oregon State (0-1)**
Yesterday: lost at TCU, 30-21
Of note: Jacquizz Rodgers tied the score midway through the third quarter, but the Horned Frogs scored a TD and a safety to put the game away. Next: vs. Louisville, Sept. 18.
-  **25 West Virginia (1-0)**
Saturday: def. Coastal Carolina, 31-0
Of note: Sophomore QB Geno Smith threw two touchdown passes in his first start, and Noel Devine rushed for 111 yards and a score. Next: at Marshall, Friday.
