TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF NEW YORK SHOWPLANE TOUR – FALL 2011

CANCELLATIONS: Cancellation Fees are imposed on every travel program due to operator and supplier rules and requirements, and travel/cancellation insurance is strongly recommended. *Cancellation dates are in effect, regardless of booking and/or payment dates.* The Cancellation Fees, *specifically for Air Tickets and specifically for Land Arrangements* on this tour program are as follows:

Airline Tickets: are fully Non-refundable as of issue date, approximately October 7, 2011. (Regardless of reason for cancellation, air tickets are non-refundable/non-transferable per rules and restrictions as set forth by specific carrier).

Additionally for Land Arrangements: Passengers whose cancellations are received in writing up to and including September 22, 2011, receive a full refund. Passengers whose cancellations are received in writing from September 23, through October 6, are charged a land fee of \$500 per person. Passengers whose cancellations are received in writing from October 7, through October 13, are charged a land fee of \$1200 per person. Passengers whose cancellations are received in writing from October 14, and beyond, or whose trips are interrupted, receive no refunds – 100% cancellation penalty will be levied. “No shows” receive no refunds. ALL telephone cancellations must be followed in writing by return receipt mail to Gulliver's Travels Inc., 460 South Graham Street, Pittsburgh PA 15232-1210, or the cancellation will be considered a “no show.” Cancellations via telephone message recorder CANNOT be accepted. Optional travel insurance information is presented upon the traveler’s request, and purchase or non-purchase of this or any other insurance is fully at the discretion of the traveler. Travelers are advised to independently investigate travel insurance other than that offered here as a service. nyf11

All such losses or expenses will be borne by the purchaser and/or passenger. Other means of conveyance may be sought and secured by the tour operator in the event of such delays or changes in schedules, sickness, weather, bankruptcies, strikes of any kind, armed conflict, acts of terrorism, quarantine, or other causes, and in each and every case, cancellation policies will remain in effect should passenger choose to cancel. Again, all such losses or expenses will be borne by the purchaser and/or passenger.
